



FOR YOU WHO BRING YOUR OWN UNIT

ARRIVAL

You can enter the campsite from Saturday 22 August 2026 at 8 AM up to and including Saturday 29 August. Check-in is open until 7 PM.

For safety and permit reasons, guests may not arrive at the check-in area before 22 August at 8 AM, and queuing before this time is not allowed. Please note the check-in address.

CHECK-IN

Arriving by car

All overnight guests arriving by car check in at Industrien ([Søndre Industrivej 1, 6270 Tønder](#)). Follow the signs posted on the approach roads into Tønder and through the town.

Please be prepared that check-in and being shown to your pitch takes time, and queues may form at busy periods.

The check-in location is designed to prevent queues from forming through central Tønder.



Have all your tickets ready on arrival and stay in the car during check-in – this will speed things up.

Write the car's registration number and a mobile phone number on the parking permit you're given, and place it in the windscreen, where it must remain visible until you leave the festival.

After check-in, follow the signs to the Tønder Festival camping area ([Papegøjevej 3, 6270 Tønder](#)).

Arriving without a vehicle

If you arrive on foot, go directly to the Camping Info tent on the main camping area ([Papegøjevej 3, 6270 Tønder](#)) and check in. Follow the signs.

Please note! You can only check in at Tønder Festival's camping areas if you have also purchased a ticket to Tønder Festival 2026.

ARRIVING OUTSIDE OPENING HOURS

For safety and permit reasons, guests may not arrive at the check-in area outside the campsite's opening hours, and queuing in the adjacent streets – Papegøjevej, Jernbanegade and Ved Slotsbanken – is not allowed.

If you arrive outside check-in hours, you can drive to [Åbenråvej 1, 6270 Tønder](#) for temporary overnight parking in your own unit.

CAR-FREE AREAS

In the car-free tent areas, Marsken and Oasen, units are placed close together.

Electricity is not available.

If you bring a car or other vehicle, it must be parked in a separate parking area close by.

Get a parking permit at check-in at Industrien. Fill it in and place it in the windscreen.

ELECTRICITY

Areas with access to electricity may only be used by guests with a camping ticket for that specific area.

Only CEE cables may be used. Maximum load: 6A/1320W – check your appliances before connecting. The nearest socket may be far away, so consider bringing an extension cable. Adapters can be rented at Camping Info.



FACILITIES

- Shower trailers with cabins are set up in several locations around the site. In addition, a larger, simply furnished shower tent with separate sections for women and men is located by the fire tower.
- At the shower/toilet facilities there are also cabins for brushing teeth, plus wash tables for light washing-up and laundry.
- Disposal basins for emptying camping toilets are located at the toilet trailers.
- Drinking water taps are available at all toilet trailers, where you can also fetch water for washing up, etc.

ORDER BREAKFAST ROLLS AT THE CAMP SITE GROCER

Breakfast rolls can be ordered at the Camp Site Grocer from Sunday 23 August. Orders must be placed the day before your desired collection. Prices are available at the Camp Site Grocer.

The Camp Site Grocer's breakfast buffet offers delicious breakfast classics. The breakfast buffet is available from Wednesday 26 August up to and including Sunday 30 August. Breakfast buffet tickets are bought at the Camp Site Grocer the day before you wish to attend, before 9:30 AM.

DEPARTURE

All guests must check out of all camping areas by Sunday 30 August at 12 noon at the latest. Remember to clear your pitch completely before you leave.

WASTE

On the camping area, waste is sorted into food waste, residual waste and plastic waste. Bring your waste to the recycling station by the Camp Site Grocer and dispose of it in the correct containers. In addition to the recycling station by the Camp Site Grocer, there are smaller containers for residual waste and for glass and plastic bottles around the site. Waste sacks and food waste bags are available at Camping Info.

HOW TO RESERVE A PITCH

If you wish to reserve a pitch for friends arriving later, you must show a copy of the ticket for their unit and the dimensions of their caravan/tent (incl. drawbar/guy lines). The reserved pitch(es) will be measured out together with a volunteer from the camping team and marked with the festival's official marking tape (bring your own pegs or sticks).

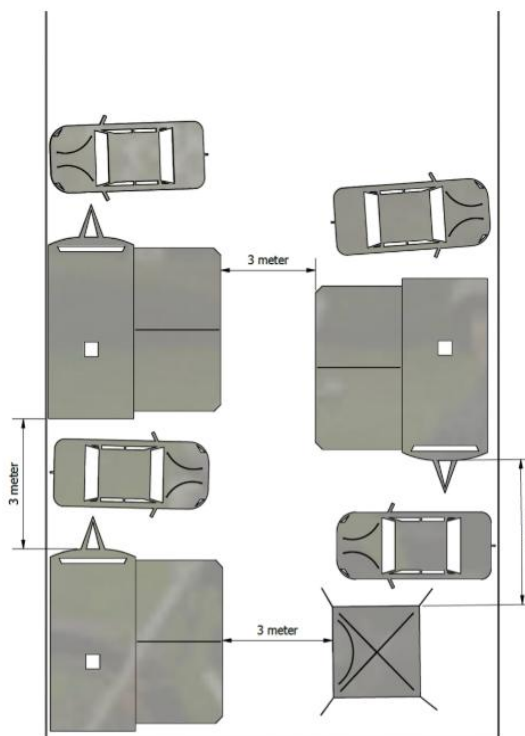


Guests are not allowed to reserve a pitch before Saturday 22 August at 8 AM. Any markings made before this time will be removed.

Areas for Tønder Festival's internal use will be marked with the festival's marking tape and, where relevant, signs. These markings must be respected.

HOW TO PLACE YOUR TENT/CARAVAN AND VEHICLE

- Your pitch is measured out together with one of the volunteers on the camping area.
- On each pitch, you may place one unit (tent/caravan/motorhome) plus one vehicle (car/motorcycle).
- A 3-metre safety distance between units must be maintained. Vehicles and gazebos/sun sails without side walls may be placed within the safety distance. It may be necessary to leave out the awning or remove side panels in order to maintain the safety distance.
- Place your caravan/tent and vehicle as shown in the illustration below.
- Units and vehicles (or parts thereof) may not be placed on fire lanes.
- Illegally placed vehicles and units will be removed at the owner's risk and expense. The same applies to units set up outside opening hours.
- Labels confirming payment for your unit and, if applicable, electricity must be attached visibly from the road – on the caravan's handle or on a tent guy line.



DRIVING ON THE CAMPING AREA

For the safety of our guests, drivers are asked to respect the following rules:

- limit all driving, both on the campsite and in and out of the site
- max. 10 km/h on the campsite
- show consideration for pedestrians and cyclists
- there are no parking spaces at the Camp Site Grocer, so walk or cycle



- vehicles parked without a parking sign (or in marked parking areas without a red parking permit) will be removed without liability and at the owner's expense

The site is closed for entry between 8 PM and 8 AM.

Necessary exits after 8 PM must be made via the exit by the Town Hall.

USE OF FIRE, GAS AND GRILLING

Open fire, including outdoor kitchens, campfires, tranguas, fireworks, torches, gas burners and candles, is prohibited.

Grilling (with both charcoal and gas grills) is only permitted in the designated grilling areas. Tables and benches are provided there.

Familiarise yourself with the location of the nearest fire-fighting equipment. Consider keeping a hand-held extinguisher within reach.

In case of fire: Call 112. State where the fire is. Try to extinguish/contain the fire.

SAFETY

Do not leave money or valuables in your tent or caravan.

Keep an eye on your neighbours' tents/caravans.

Inform Camping Info if you notice any suspicious persons.

In case of theft, contact Camping Info or the police, tel. 114.

OTHER RULES AND PRACTICAL INFORMATION

- Only festival guests with a camping wristband may stay overnight on the site. Day visits without an overnight stay are permitted.
- Pets (max. 2) may be brought onto the campsite, but not onto the festival site. Dogs must be kept on a leash, and pets must not disturb other guests.
- Tønder Festival does not undertake to tow or pull free cars/caravans. Please contact Falck or a similar service.
- Pitches on the camping areas are not numbered. If a pitch number appears on your camping ticket, you can disregard it. When you arrive, our volunteers will direct you within the area you have booked — please follow their guidance, so we can fit everyone in.
