



FOR YOU STAYING IN A TENTHOUSE, RETENT OR GLAMPING TENT

ARRIVAL

You can enter the campsite from Saturday 22 August 2026 at 8 AM up to and including Saturday 29 August. Check-in is open until 7 PM.

For safety and permit reasons, guests may not arrive at the check-in area before 22 August at 8 AM, and queuing before this time is not allowed. Please note the check-in address.

CHECK-IN

Arriving by car

All overnight guests arriving by car check in at Industrien ([Søndre Industrivej 1, 6270 Tønder](#)). Follow the signs posted on the approach roads into Tønder and through the town.

Please be prepared that check-in and being shown to your pitch takes time, and queues may form at busy periods.

The check-in location is designed to prevent queues from forming through central Tønder.

Have all your tickets ready on arrival and stay in the car during check-in – this will speed things up.



Write the car's registration number and a mobile phone number on the parking permit you're given, and place it in the windscreen, where it must remain visible until you leave the festival.

After check-in, follow the signs to the Tønder Festival camping area ([Papegøjevej 3, 6270 Tønder](#)).

Then go to Camping Info, where the volunteers will direct you to your accommodation.

Arriving without a vehicle

If you arrive on foot, go directly to the Camping Info tent on the main camping area ([Papegøjevej 3, 6270 Tønder](#)) and check in. Follow the signs. At Camping Info you will be directed to your accommodation.

Please note! You can only check in at Tønder Festival's camping areas if you have also purchased a ticket to Tønder Festival 2026.

PARKING

There will be a parking space next to or in the immediate vicinity of your accommodation. Ask at Camping Info if you are in doubt.

RESERVING ACCOMMODATION FOR OTHER GUESTS

If you wish to reserve a Glamping tent, Tenthouse or ReTent for other guests arriving later, you must show a copy of their accommodation ticket on arrival, after which the accommodation will be reserved by the volunteers.

ELECTRICITY AND FACILITIES

Electricity

Glamping tents and Tenthouses have electricity. It is intended for charging phones, power banks and similar devices – not for high-consumption appliances such as hairdryers, kettles, fan heaters or refrigerators. The system cannot support this, and it is not possible to purchase additional electricity.

If you use a CPAP machine or other essential medical equipment, please email us at info@tf.dk before the festival, and we will find a solution.

Shower, toilet and water

Shower trailers with cabins are located in several places on the site, and by the fire tower you'll find a large shower tent, simply furnished, with separate sections for women and men. At the shower and toilet facilities there are power outlets, cabins for brushing teeth, and wash tables for washing up and light laundry. Drinking water can be collected at all toilet trailers.

Your accommodation

If you'd like to be able to lock your accommodation, bring a small padlock – you can also buy one at the Camp Site Grocer.

Remember to zip up all zippers completely when you leave, to avoid rain damage.



If you notice any faults or issues, please contact Camping Info. We will fix them as soon as possible, dealing with urgent problems first.

SUN SAILS AND GAZEBOS

If you have a Tenthouse or ReTent, you are welcome to set up a sun sail or a small gazebo. It must stay within your own pitch, so that it neither blocks the fire lane nor disturbs your neighbours.

At the Glamping tents, gazebos may **not** be set up.

If you're in doubt, ask the volunteers on the Camping Team — they're happy to help.

ORDER BREAKFAST ROLLS AT THE CAMP SITE GROCER

Breakfast rolls can be ordered at the Camp Site Grocer from Sunday 23 August. Orders must be placed the day before your desired collection. Prices are available at the Camp Site Grocer.

The Camp Site Grocer's breakfast buffet offers delicious breakfast classics. The breakfast buffet is available from Wednesday 26 August up to and including Sunday 30 August. Breakfast buffet tickets are bought at the Camp Site Grocer the day before you wish to attend, before 9:30 AM.

WASTE

On the camping area, waste is sorted into food waste, residual waste and plastic waste. Bring your waste to the recycling station by the Camp Site Grocer and dispose of it in the correct containers. In addition to the recycling station by the Camp Site Grocer, there are smaller containers for residual waste and for glass and plastic bottles around the site. Waste sacks and food waste bags are available at Camping Info.

DEPARTURE

All guests must check out of all camping areas by Sunday 30 August at 12 noon at the latest. No fixtures or fittings may be taken from your accommodation. Remember to clear your accommodation and the surrounding area completely before you leave.

USE OF FIRE, GAS AND GRILLING

Open fire, including outdoor kitchens, campfires, tranguas, fireworks, torches, gas burners and candles, is prohibited.

Grilling (with both charcoal and gas grills) is only permitted in the designated grilling areas. Tables and benches are provided there.

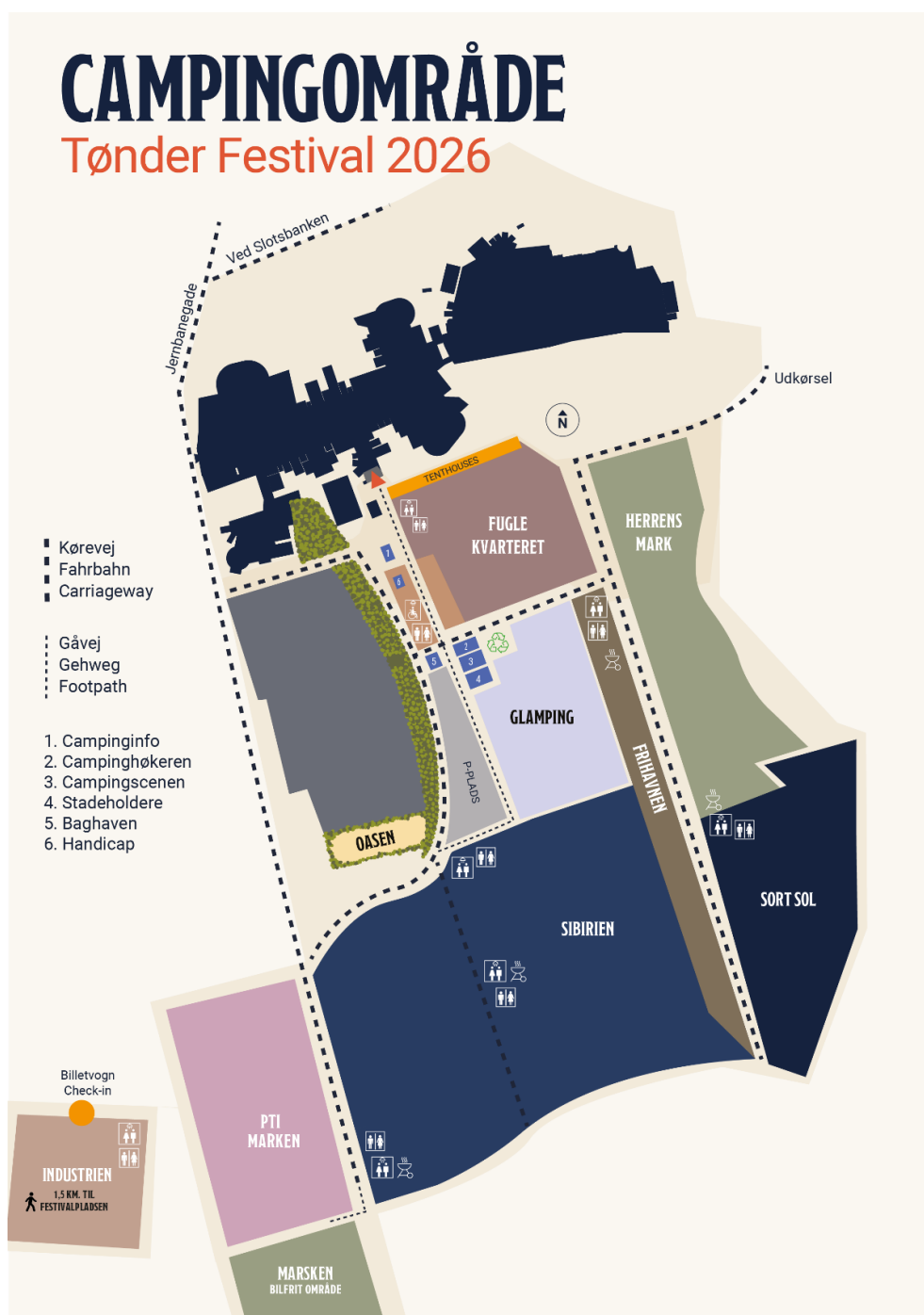
Familiarise yourself with the location of the nearest fire-fighting equipment. Consider keeping a hand-held extinguisher within reach.



In case of fire: Call 112. State where the fire is. Try to extinguish/contain the fire.

SAFETY

Do not leave money or valuables in your tent or caravan.

Keep an eye on your neighbours' tents/caravans.

Inform Camping Info if you notice any suspicious persons.

In case of theft, contact Camping Info or the police, tel. 114.

OTHER RULES AND PRACTICAL INFORMATION

- Only festival guests with a camping wristband may stay overnight on the site. Day visits without an overnight stay are permitted.
- Pets (max. 2) may be brought onto the campsite, but not onto the festival site. Dogs must be kept on a leash, and pets must not disturb other guests.
- Tønder Festival does not undertake to tow or pull free cars/caravans. Please contact Falck or a similar service.
- Accommodation units on the camping areas are not specifically numbered. If a pitch number appears on your camping ticket, you can disregard it. When you arrive, our volunteers will direct you to the accommodation you have booked.
